RE: Approval for Professional Services Contract with IT Pipes

**Scope:** Collections currently uses IT Pipes software to manage CCTV footage of sewer pipes. With this professional services contract, IT Pipes will implement a web-based version of the software, allowing access from any computer.

**Term:** Five years

Reject all Bids for public works contract (A20-0480)

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### **Request:**

We request the authorization to reject all bids received on a public works construction project for a new traffic signal at the intersection of Rice Mine Road and Rock Quarry Drive.

### **Description:**

Bids were received on October 27, 2020 in the Council Chambers. Two bidders presented. The low bid of \$164,713.95 was within budget; However, Engineering recommends terminating the project. The award of the project was previously approved by projects committee on 11/03/2020.

### **Funding:**

General Fund RFFI, account number: 20309030-16006

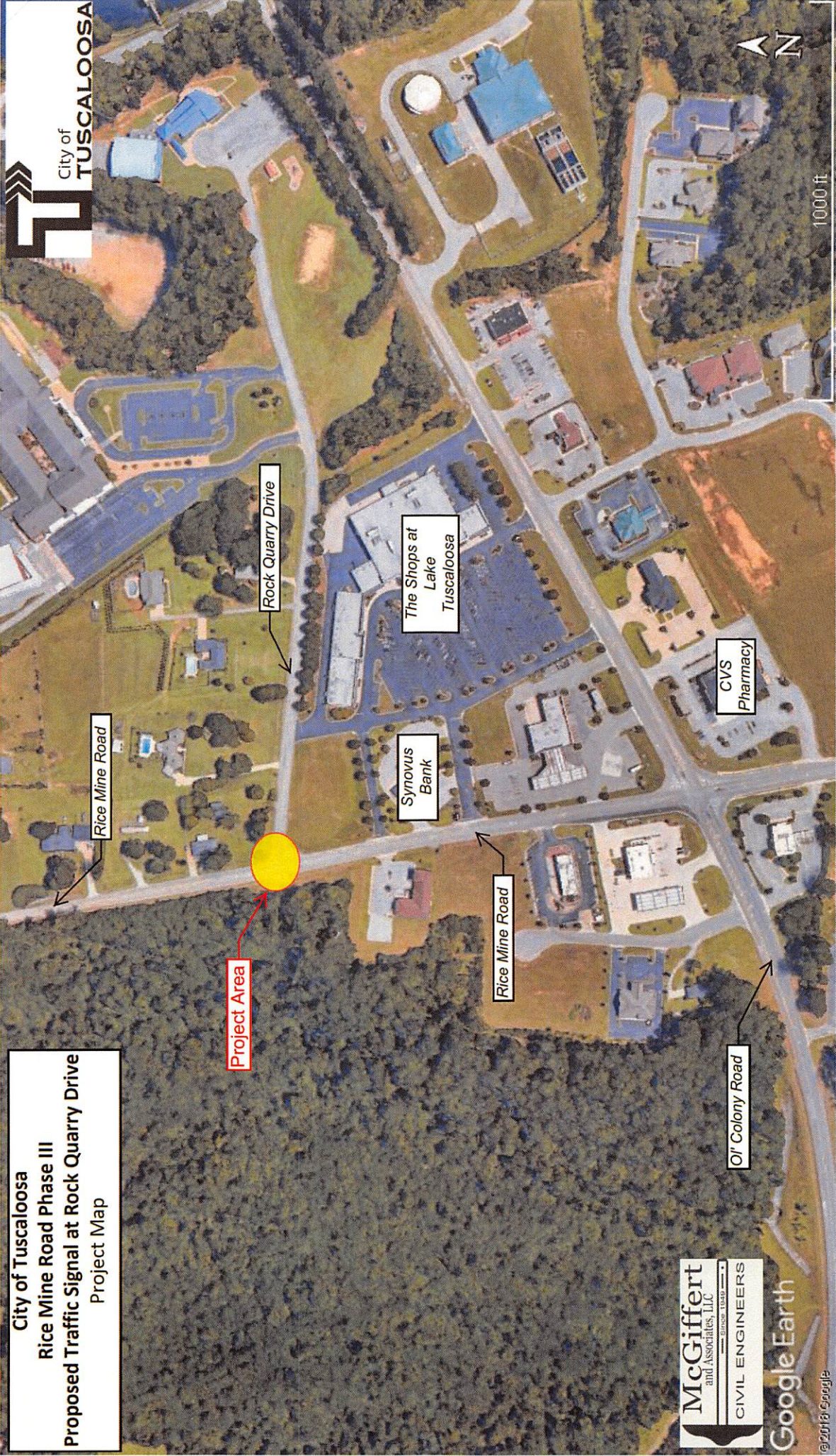

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## **Memorandum**

**RE: Short 16<sup>th</sup> Street Camera Installation**

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### Project Description

Install cameras and fiber in the area of Short 16<sup>th</sup> Street and 28<sup>th</sup> Ave

- Run a fiber cable (attached to the existing pole line) from a splice point on Dinah Washington, down Short 16th St. to the southeast corner of 28th Ave.
- A camera pole & power junction pole would be installed in the southeast corner of Short 16th St. & 28th Ave. Three cameras would be affixed to the camera pole, two fixed camera to the eastward and westward directions of short 16th St. and a PTZ camera selective viewing.
- New power sources will need to be installed by APCO

### Project Budget

Estimate cost is approximately \$12,000.00. This included fiber, cameras, poles, misc. materials, camera licenses, future storage escrow (IT has advised that on the direction of the Mayor all camera installations require a \$500.00/camera escrow for future storage needs.)
