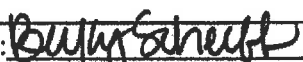
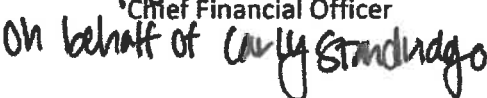

TO HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL LANDMARKS

WHEREAS, Section 24-106 of the Code of Tuscaloosa allows the City Council after due notice and a public hearing to allow the use of an Historical or Architectural Landmark which is not otherwise permitted in the district and which is located upon finding that: (1) A normally permitted use is not economically or practically feasible, or would not be in the interest of historical preservation; and (2) the proposed use will tend to promote the maintenance or restoration of the unique, historical or architectural qualities of the property; and,

WHEREAS, Half Price, LLC has requested permission to use the structure located on 2010 Paul W. Bryant Drive as a duplex; and,

WHEREAS, 2010 Paul W. Bryant Drive is in a BGO (General Business-Office District) Zoning District and a duplex residential use is not allowed in a BGO Zoning District; however, 2010 Paul W. Bryant Drive is also in the Druid City Historic District and is eligible for permission pursuant to Section 24-106 provided that the City Council will designate a legal non-conforming status to the structure and by such designation allow said residential structure to qualify for use as a duplex residence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA that a public hearing be, and is hereby scheduled for April 12, 2022, at 6:00, P.M. in the Council Chamber of City Hall for the request by Half Price, LLC to use the residential structure located at 2010 Paul W. RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE FOR A HEARING TO SET THE  
COST OF DEMOLISHING THE BUILDING AT 3304 BECK STREET

WHEREAS, the building located in the City of Tuscaloosa at 3304 Beck Street, owned by Charlie B. Moore and as recorded in Deed Book 0794, Page No. 0378, was declared unsafe to the extent of being a public nuisance by the City Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> day of April 2021, and was ordered to be demolished by city forces pursuant to Ala. Code Section 11-53B-1 et seq. (1975); and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-53B-1 et seq. requires the appropriate city official to report to the City Council of Tuscaloosa the cost of demolition and to hold a hearing on the setting of said cost, which shall include the cost of demolition and court costs; and,

WHEREAS, the City Clerk hereby reports to the City Council that the cost to demolish said building was \$6,515.57; and,

WHEREAS, the City Clerk shall give notice by first-class mail to all entities having an interest in the property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA, as follows:

1. That a hearing will be held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 2022, at 6:00 p.m. to set the cost of demolishing the building located at 3304 Beck Street in the amount of \$6,515.57 plus court costs.

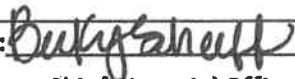
