RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE PROGRAM YEAR 2020 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT CORONAVIRUS (ESG-CV) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2021 the City entered into agreement with the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs under the 2020 Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) program to provide for the administration, homeless prevention, rapid re-housing, street outreach, and emergency shelter costs; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs has granted a contract amendment to extend the performance period to November 30, 2022 to allow time for funds to be completely expended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESEOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA, that the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to execute the amended grant agreement extending the performance period of the 2020 ESG-CV program and the City Clerk is authorized to attest the same.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S.

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR 2021 GRANT ASSISTANCE FOR

THE HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2008 the City of Tuscaloosa entered into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to become the Administrator of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) covering Tuscaloosa and Tuscaloosa County and to receive HMIS grant funds for the administration of said system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa was awarded \$42,000 in grant funds for the operation of the Homeless Management Information System from the 2021 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program designed to provide assistance to homeless persons; and

WHEREAS, \$10,500 of the Community Development Block Grant funds paid for the operation of the City's Housing Counseling Program will be used as the 25 percent required match for the HMIS grant funds; and

WHEREAS, \$10,500 of project leveraging in the form of utilities for the implementation of HMIS will be used as the 25 percent required for leveraging for HMIS grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the necessary documentation to include memorandum of understanding(s), certifications, and other documents will be executed for the administration and implementation of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA:

That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement and all certifications, memorandum of understanding(s), and other documents required in relation to the City's implementation and administration of HMIS through 2021 CoC Program grant funds.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR 2022 GRANT ASSISTANCE FOR THE HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2008 the City of Tuscaloosa entered into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to become the Administrator of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) serving the AL 506 Continuum of Care; Community Homeless Assessment Local Education and Networking Groups (CHALENG) to receive HMIS grant funds for the administration of said system; and

WHEREAS, on the same day the City of Tuscaloosa entered into agreement to serve as the Collaborative Applicant on behalf of CHALENG for the annual renewal process for Continuum of Care (CoC) program funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa plans to apply for \$42,000.00 in project award for the operation of the Homeless Management Information System from the 2022 Continuum of Care (COC) Program designed to provide assistance to homeless persons; and

WHEREAS, \$10,500.00 of the Community Development Block Grant funds paid for the operation of the City's Housing Counseling Program will be used as the 25 percent required match for the HMIS grant funds, and

WHEREAS, \$10,500.00 of project leveraging in the form of utilities will be used as the 25 percent required for further leveraging for HMIS grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA:

- 1. That the Office of Community and Neighborhood Services is hereby authorized to complete the preparation of an application to apply for the above referenced grant funds under the 2022 Continuum of Care (COC) Program and that said application is authorized to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to execute all certifications and other documents required in relation to the City's application for and administration of the 2022 Continuum of Care (COC) Program grant funds.
