RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY'S CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER) FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2022 AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE CAPER TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the City of Tuscaloosa to submit a Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) at the end of each program year; and

WHEREAS the City's CAPER provides information to the public and to HUD about program year 2022 accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Community and Neighborhood Services will advertise the completion of the CAPER in The Tuscaloosa News in order to give the Citizens of Tuscaloosa a 15 day time period to review the document and comment on the same.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA:

1. That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized, for and as an act of the City, to execute all certifications and other documents required in relation to the submission of said CAPER to HUD.
2. That the City's Office of Community and Neighborhood Services is hereby authorized to submit said CAPER to HUD following the 15 day citizen review comment period.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ALABAMA FOR A GRANT UNDER THE 2023 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE SALVATION ARMY, TEMPORARY EMERGENCY SERVICES, Inc., AND SAN, INC. (d.b.a. TURNING POINT) FOR STREET OUTREACH, HOMELESS PREVENTION, RAPID RE-HOUSING, AND TO PAY EMERGENCY SHELTER COSTS

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has received funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the 2023 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program to provide assistance for the homeless and victims of domestic abuse and to prevent homelessness in all areas within the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, The Salvation Army, Temporary Emergency Services, Inc. (TES), and Turning Point have requested that the City submit an application to the State of Alabama for 2023 ESG Program funds totaling \$222,000 to provide funds for street outreach, homeless prevention and rapid rehousing and to pay emergency shelter costs; and

WHEREAS, The Salvation Army, TES, and Turning Point have committed to provide the required match of \$222,000; but the City of Tuscaloosa recognizes that as the grant applicant, it is responsible for providing the required match should The Salvation Army, TES, and/or Turning Point be unable to provide the full match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa plans to apply for \$9,200 in ESG administration costs and \$11,500.00 in HMIS costs and assumes the responsibility for in-kind match; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to assist The Salvation Army, TES, and Turning Point in its efforts to help homeless persons and to prevent homelessness by submitting an application to the State of Alabama for ESG Program funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA:

1. That the Office of Community and Neighborhood Services is hereby authorized submit an application for an Emergency Solutions Grant in the amount of \$242,700.00 to provide funds for the administration of the grant, HMIS, street outreach, homeless prevention, rapid re-housing and to pay emergency shelter costs and that said application is authorized to be submitted to the State of Alabama.

2. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to execute all certifications and other documents required in relation to the City's application for and administration of the 2023 Emergency Solutions Grant Program funds.
