BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA that various sections of Chapter 7 of the Code of Tuscaloosa be amended as follows:

SECTION ONE. Be it Ordained that Chapter 7 Article II, Business Licenses., Subsection 7-18 entitled "Business License Schedule" be amended as follows:

(18) Pay Schedule Y:

On the first \$100,000.00 (gross receipts) \$125.00

Plus an additional amount of \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$100,000.00 and less than \$1,000,000.00,

Plus an additional amount of \$0.50 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$1,000,000.00 and less than \$10,000,000.00,

Plus an additional amount of \$0.25 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$10,000,000.00 and less than \$100,000,000.00,

Plus an additional amount of \$0.14 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$100,000,000.00 and less than \$1,000,000,000.00,

Plus an additional amount of \$0.07 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$1,000,000,000.00 and less than \$10,000,000,000.00,

Plus an additional amount of \$0.04 per \$1,000.00 on all gross receipts over \$10,000,000,000.00.

For purposes of payment schedule Y as applied to any person in the business of manufacturing, or any other payment schedule applicable to a manufacturer, the term "gross receipts" shall mean and include "the value of goods produced or manufactured."

The "value of goods produced or manufactured" shall be measured by the gross receipt when the goods are ultimately sold, regardless of when or where the sale occurs.

SECTION TWO. Be it Ordained that Chapter 7 Article II, Business Licenses., Subsection 7-18 entitled "Business License Schedule" be amended as follows:
