Chairperson Howard called the meeting to order.

Chairperson Howard welcomed the University of Alabama's journalism students and thanked them for attending today's meeting.

Chief Brent Blankley introduced the Assistant Chiefs and gave an overview of the Tuscaloosa Police Department. He also gave a brief of the task force on TPD's fiscal year 2024 goals.

City Attorney Scott Holmes called for Executive Sessions as follows:

- (1) To discuss security plans, procedures, assessments, measures, or systems or the security or safety of persons, structures, facilities, or other infrastructures, the public disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to be detrimental to public safety or welfare. If the discussion involves critical infrastructure or critical energy infrastructure information, the owners and operators of such infrastructure must be given notice and an opportunity to attend the session.

Councilmember Faile made a motion to enter executive session. Councilmember Busby seconded the motion. Chairperson Howard called the roll for a vote. All Councilmembers present voted "yes"; no, none. Chairperson Howard announced the results of the vote and declared them in executive session.
