ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA RELATING TO WATER AND SEWER RATES  
(OCA-23-1238)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA as follows:

**SECTION ONE.** That Section 16-125(c) of the Code of Tuscaloosa is hereby amended to read as follows:

**“Sec. 16-125. - Security deposits**

*Deposit.* The amount of the security deposit imposed and collected pursuant to the terms and conditions of this section shall be based upon the meter size serving the customer's account as follows:

Meter Size (inches)	Amount of Deposit
5/8	\$80.00
3/4	\$100.00
1	\$120.00
All over 1	\$120.00
<b>Fire Hydrant</b>	<b>\$50.00</b>

**SECTION TWO.** That Section 16-130 of the Code of Tuscaloosa is hereby amended to read as follows:

**“Sec. 16-130. – Installation service charges for new service.**

Service Charges for installation of new meters and for connection to water main for new service shall be based on the size of the water meter to be installed, as follows:

Diameter of Water Meter	Charge
¾ inch meter (domestic/irrigation/13-D fire)	\$ 1,018.00
¾ inch Subdivision Stub-out Meter (Drop In)	\$ 450.00
1 inch meter (domestic/irrigation/13-D fire)	\$ 1,120.00
1 inch Subdivision Stub-out Meter (Drop In)	\$ 500.00
1½ inch meter (irrigation set/13-D fire)	\$ 3,205.00
1½ inch meter (commercial)	\$ 4,150.00
2 inch meter (irrigation set)	\$ 3,250.00

2 inch meter (commercial)	\$ 5,125.00
Larger than 2 inches	Actual Cost, including labor
Fire hydrant water meter	\$30.00 per 30 day permit and per each renewal

The amount charged shall be determined at the rate applicable at the time the services are rendered and not when requested. Meter sets will not be sold or authorized and will not be made unless the applicant has obtained a building permit from the city. The foregoing provision shall apply only in those instances in which a building permit is required. For any meter greater than two (2) inches in size, actual costs set will be determined by the office of the city engineer."

**SECTION THREE. EFFECTIVE DATE:** The rates, fees and charges established herein shall be effective January 1, 2024.
