The Office of Community and Neighborhood Services (CNS) is requesting authorization to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for 2024 and 2025 grant assistance for the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)

Resolution Summary:

In addition, CNS is requesting authorization and approval to submit an application to HUD for 2024 and 2025 grant assistance for the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) totaling \$42,000 for project year 2024 and \$42,000 for project year 2025.

\$10,500.00 of the Community Development Block Grant funds paid for the operation of the City's Housing Counseling Program for each project award year will be used as the 25 percent required match for the HMIS grant funds. In addition, 10,500.00 of project leveraging in the form of utilities for each project award year will be used as the 25 percent required for further leveraging for HMIS grant funds.
