The City of Tuscaloosa adopted the National Incident Management System by resolution on December 14, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa continues to implement NIMS in order to maximize effective communications, incident command, and other features of NIMS in the event of an attack or other disaster, and also to remain eligible for federal preparedness assistance; and

WHEREAS the City of Tuscaloosa regularly applies for and receives grants from the Department of Homeland Security; and

WHEREAS the Department of Homeland Security has requested that the City of Tuscaloosa reaffirm the utilization of NIMS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA as follows:

That the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as promulgated by the United States Department of Homeland Security continues to be adopted by the City of Tuscaloosa in accordance with the implementation schedule required by federal or state law, rule, regulation, or executive order. The Mayor is authorized to execute a resolution affirming the city's adoption of NIMS.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 23-134 of the Code of Tuscaloosa  
(OCA-24-0054)**

The following subsection of the Code of Tuscaloosa is hereby amended, and all other sections and/or subsections shall remain unchanged.

SECTION ONE. That Subsection 23-134(g) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 23-134. Rules for operation of pedicabs.

“(g) *Fares.* Any fare charged by a pedicab operator shall be on a per person, per ride basis and shall be clearly posted on the pedicab.”
