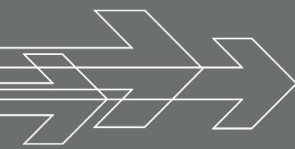

**Request:**

Requesting authorization for a minor public works contract with Morrow Water Technologies, Inc. for the purchase and installation of a fluoride tank at Jerry Plott Water Treatment Plant in the amount of \$26,534.80.

**Project Description:**

Replacement of the Fluoride bulk storage tank at the Jerry Plott Water Treatment Plant.

**Project Schedule:**

Once the tank is on site, removal and installation of the new tank should take no more than 8 hours.

**Project Funding:**

The total cost of the project is \$26,534.80. This project is primarily funded with a grant from the Alabama Department of Public Health for \$25,000 (maximum award amount). The remaining cost of \$1,534.80 will be funded from the Plott Plant Operational budget; 60109044-4010.

### Request:

The Office of the City Engineer (OCE) is requesting authorization for the mayor to execute a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with ALDOT for signal Improvements at the intersections of Mercedes Drive and Daimler Benz Blvd. and the Exit 89 Southbound on-ramp and Daimler Benz Blvd. ALDOT will install all improvements, and the city will take over maintenance.

### Project Scope:

There is an upcoming ATRP project at exit 89 on I-20/59 to make operational and safety improvements at the SB on-ramp and NB off-ramp. As a result, there will be a new traffic signal at Daimler Benz Blvd and the SB on-ramp and upgrades to the signal at the NB off-ramp at Daimler Benz Blvd. A maintenance agreement is required for the installation and upgrade of traffic control signals, see attached.

### Project Schedule:

The time for completion has not been determined.

### Project Funding:

This project is being performed at no cost to the City of Tuscaloosa.
