RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION BY CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION, PERMANENT EASEMENTS OR RIGHT OF WAY FOR UTILITIES AND ACCESS AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS FOR THE MCWRIGHTS FERRY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (21-0290)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The McWrights Ferry Road Improvements Project is a public infrastructure project that will address a concern, which has existed since the completion of Lake Tuscaloosa in 1970, regarding the health, safety and welfare of both Tuscaloosa County and City of Tuscaloosa residents who live East of Lake Tuscaloosa. The Project will also address traffic congestion on McWrights Ferry Road, New Watermelon Road, Rice Mine Road and the Old Colony Extension Road. The reason for addressing the two issues as set forth above is due to the existing two lane road, New Watermelon Road, located on top of the Lake Tuscaloosa Dam which was constructed in 1970. Since 1970 the number of subdivisions and corresponding residents, in both the County and City East of Lake Tuscaloosa, has increased exponentially and the existing two lane road remains the only expedient and convenient means for County and City residents to access their property. There is another avenue to access their property from Highway 69 North to the Yellowcreek Road then to New Watermelon Road, however this alternative route can take up to one hour or more. In the event that New Watermelon Road is inaccessible, either on the Dam or past the Dam, there is a health, safety and welfare emergency concerning critical delays in response times to calls for police, fire suppression, medical emergency and transport and to provide other essential governmental services. Whenever Watermelon Road is inaccessible, Emergency responders must use the Highway 69 North alternative causing critical delays for emergency responses.

The Project will also address traffic congestion. In kinship with the health, safety and welfare concern, traffic likewise has only one convenient and expedient means along New Watermelon Road on top of the Dam for ingress and egress. The hope and desire for the Project, concerning traffic, is that school traffic will continue to use New Watermelon Road over the Dam and commuter traffic will instead use the improved McWrights Ferry Road to cross North River into Downtown Tuscaloosa.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined and declared by the City Council of Tuscaloosa that it is necessary, useful and expedient to acquire property acquisitions regarding right of way, permanent easements, temporary construction easements and easements for utilities and access

for the McWrights Ferry Road Improvements Project, a Public Infrastructure Project, and that such Project be constructed, used, maintained and operated across certain property located within Tuscaloosa County, Alabama; and, to that end, certain tracts of property for all purposes, presently, and from time to time in the future as the City may elect for construction of such Project on, over, across, or through lands as hereinafter described, be acquired by condemnation proceedings pursuant to Section 11-47-170 and Section 11-80-1 of the Code of Alabama (1975); and, that the City Attorney be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to institute and prosecute to conclusions such condemnation proceedings.

It is further declared that said property herein authorized to be acquired for the construction use, maintenance and operation of the Project and for the uses and purposes herein described, as located on, over, across and through the following described parcel of land in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, to-wit:

All identified Tracts of land describing easements or property acquisition regarding right of way, permanent easements, temporary construction easements and easements for utilities and access for the McWrights Ferry Road Improvements Project that have not been executed by the respective Tract property owners by February 1, 2022 and/or received by the City.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to cause to be done any and all things necessary, useful or expedient in carrying into effect all the things herein authorized, directed or provided to be done, and is also authorized to do, or cause to be done, any and all things necessary, useful or expedient to effect the condemnation of said land and other rights as aforesaid; that the said Mayor be, and he is hereby, further authorized to execute all bonds and other papers necessary or useful to be done in such condemnation proceedings and to sign and issue checks for the payment of any and all costs, damages or compensation incurred or fixed in said condemnation proceedings.
