

PRE-COUNCIL BRIEFING MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Maddox updated the Council on the departure of City Attorney Glenda Webb and the hiring process forthcoming.

City Clerk Carly Standridge requested permission to cancel council and council committee meetings on Tuesday, April 13 due to the run-off election in Districts 1 and 6. Council approved.

City Attorney Glenda Webb reviewed the remaining agenda items.

Councilmember Busby reviewed the day's meeting schedule and dates to remember.
