2005 DINAH WASHINGTON AVENUE AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A LIEN

WHEREAS, the person(s) last assessed for the property taxes at 2005 Dinah Washington Avenue with owners of record being Holy Temple Church of God in Christ, as recorded in Deed Book 525, Page No. 131; more particularly described as:

the following described real estate situated in Tuscaloosa County Alabama to wit: the following described portion of lot 8 block 480 of Tuscaloosa Coal Iron and Land Company Survey: starting at the northeast corner of said lot 8 run thence southerly along the east boundary line of. Said lot 8 a distance of 90 feet to the point of beginning of the property herein conveyed thence turn right through a deflection angle of 90 degrees and run westerly a distance of 91.19 feet to a point on the west boundary line of said lot 8. WHEREAS, Section 11-53B-1 et seq. states that the cost of demolition, and court costs shall constitute a lien and shall be a superior lien to all other except for taxes.

1. That the cost for the demolition of the building located at 2005 Dinah Washington Avenue and for court costs be, and it is hereby set at \$9,810.03, and the persons(s) last assessed for the property is Holy Temple Church of God in Christ, as recorded in Deed Book 525, Page No. 131.

That the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this resolution in the office of the Probate Judge of Tuscaloosa County, and the cost of demolition and court costs shall constitute a lien in the amount of \$9,810.03 against the property at 2005 Dinah Washington Avenue, as recorded in Deed Book 525, Page No. 131.

ORDINANCE NO. 9416

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 4
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA
(OCA-23-1059)**

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Tuscaloosa City Council that Chapter 16, Article III, Division 4 of the Municipal Code of the City of Tuscaloosa is amended to add the following as Section 16-89.10:

Sec. 16-89.10 Limited Exception for Certain Nonresidential Potential Establishments Within the Area of Limited Sewer Access

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Sanitary Sewer Access Policy set out in this Division 4, a nonresidential potential establishment located outside the City's corporate limits may be allowed to access and connect to the City's sanitary sewer system, only if all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The potential establishment is located within the area of limited sewer access, as defined in Section 16-89.1 and Section 16-89.5;
- (2) The lot or parcel on which the potential establishment will be located is currently served by an existing, active, nonresidential sanitary sewer connection, and is a current direct water customer of the City;
- (3) The lot or parcel on which the potential establishment will be located is currently unable to be annexed into the City's corporate limits. The person or entity applying for a sanitary sewer access permit under this section has the burden of submitting information and/or documentation to satisfy the City Engineer that the lot is currently unable to be annexed into the City's corporate limits, such as, by way of example only, information that the lot is not contiguous to the City's existing corporate limits, and that the intervening contiguous property owners will not consent to annexation;
- (4) The potential establishment will be a direct water customer of the City;

(5) The potential establishment will be able to access and connect to the City's sanitary sewer system without any extension or enlargement of the City's existing sanitary sewer mains and/or lines; and

(6) The existing capacity of the City's sanitary sewer system in the area of the potential establishment is adequate and sufficient to serve the potential establishment. The person or entity applying for a sanitary sewer access permit under this section shall pay the costs of any and all studies or other services necessary to assess the available capacity of the sanitary sewer system. The City Engineer shall have the sole discretion to determine whether the sanitary sewer system in the area has adequate and sufficient capacity to serve the potential establishment.

(b) Any person or entity applying for a sanitary sewer access permit pursuant to this section shall be subject to and shall comply with all other provisions of the City Code governing sanitary sewers, including without limitation the City's design manual for the sanitary sewer system, and all application fees, permit fees, service fees, and other fees that would be required if the applicant's potential establishment were located within the City's corporate limits.
